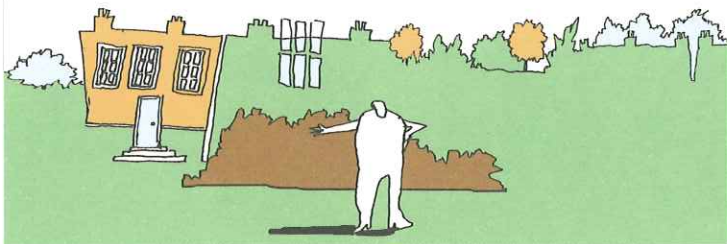


What you can expect

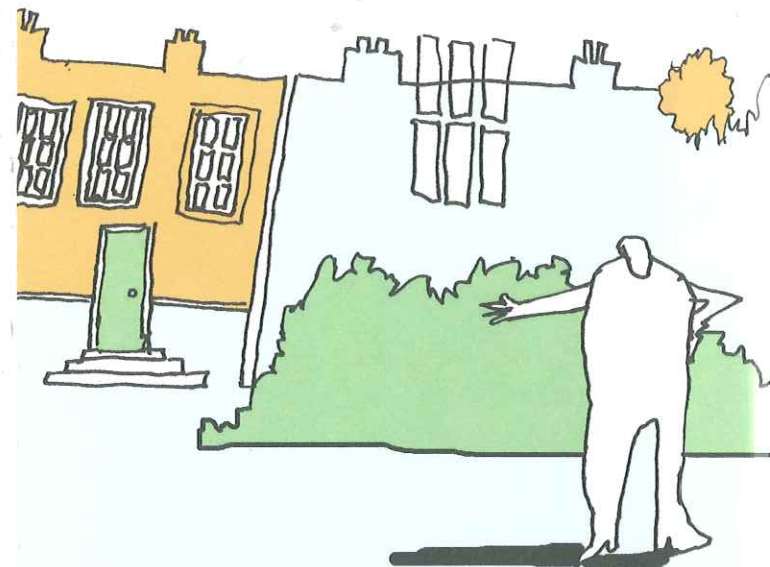
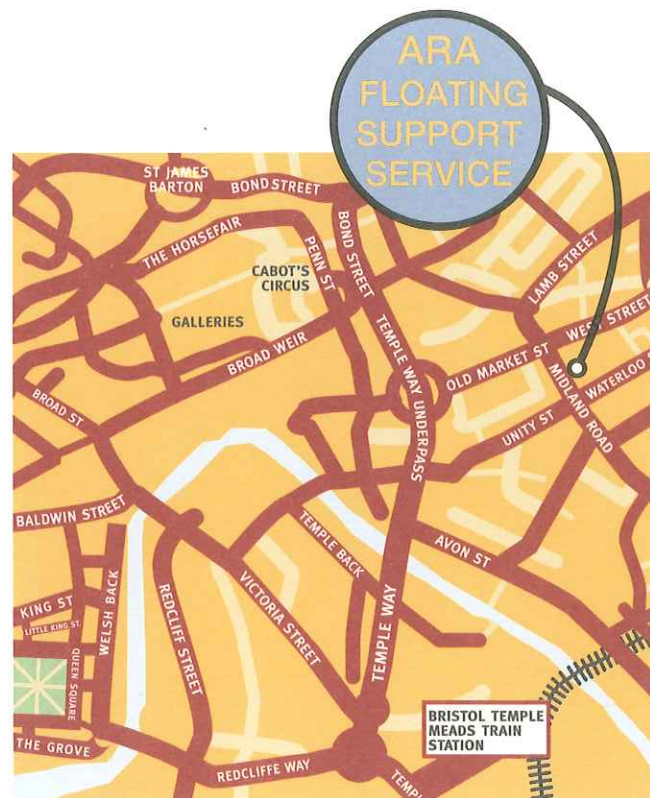

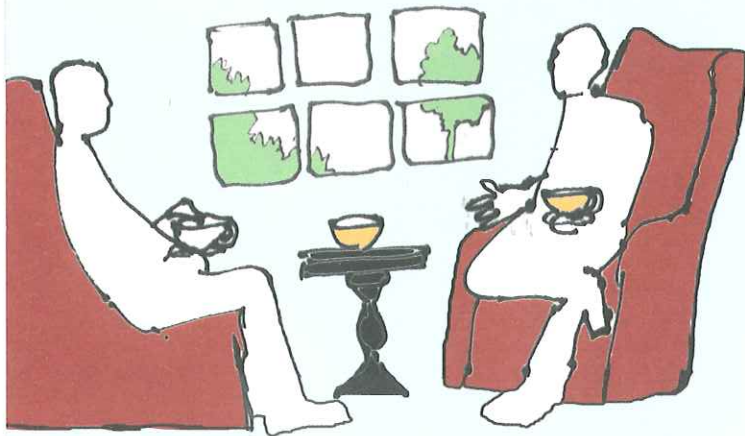

Who are we?

The Addiction Recovery Agency (ARA) has 21 years experience of providing specialist services for people with drug and/or alcohol issues. We provide a range of services including advice and information, counselling, residential treatment, supported housing and floating support.

Our mission is to provide high quality treatment and support services in order to reduce the harm caused by substance misuse and the consequent damage to individuals, their families and communities.



What is the Floating Support Service?

Based in central Bristol, the Floating Support Service provides a resettlement and tenancy sustainment service for people with a history of drug and/or alcohol misuse who live in the Bristol area.

We can support clients who are moving into or already living in their own accommodation. This could be a private rented, Local Authority or Housing Association property.

Clients are also supported to engage with a range of structured treatment services to help address their drug and/or alcohol misuse.



The Floating Support Service provides:

- Practical and emotional support to help clients manage their accommodation and live independently
- Support with budgeting, managing debts, bill paying, applying for grants to buy furniture
- Accessing community services such as educational courses or back to work opportunities
- Support in accessing drug and/or alcohol treatment.

Eligibility criteria

- Aged 18 - 65
- Have a history of drug or alcohol misuse
- In need of a housing related support service
- Willing to engage with an individually tailored support package
- Agree to accept support from and engage with Bristol based treatment services to address drug/alcohol misuse issues.
